CHURCH SCHOOL NEWS

The Church School Festival of Faith will be Sunday, February 26th. Students in N3 through 6th grade will perform special class presentations immediately following Divine Liturgy. Coffee hour will be hosted by the church school. Visit the atrium to view student artwork on display.

Sunday of Orthodoxy Procession, March 4th: Nursery 3 through 6th grade church school students should bring an icon to church with them for participating in the procession of icons. As children complete communion, they should begin to line up with their class for the procession.

N3, N4, and Kindergarten will line up against the wall at the front of the church in the baptismal font area.

Parents should escort their children to that area, and their teachers will be there to wait with them.

1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th grades should proceed to the Fellowship Hall. They will line up with their classes in the designated area by the door to the stairs leading up to the baptismal font area. When the procession is to begin, their teachers will lead them up the spiral staircase.

Participation for 7th through High School students is optional. Any of these students who would like to process should meet in the Fellowship Hall.

The procession will end with all students on the solea. Upon dismissal by Fr. Angelo, students and teachers will proceed to their classrooms for a shortened lesson.

The SS. Peter and Paul Oratorical Festival will be Friday, March 9th following Salutations at 7 p.m. Junior and Senior division speeches will be presented, and all essays, icons and poems will be due that evening. 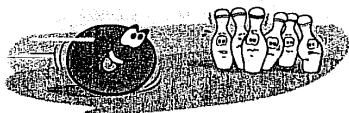

The Triodion & Stewardship – Part I

After reading the title of this article, you might be saying to yourself (or even others around you), “Now hold on just a minute! Not another piece on Stewardship! Haven’t we heard enough already? We get it! We are not giving enough, and the Church wants us to give more! If I hear the word ‘Stewardship’ one more time, I’m going to go crazy! All this Stewardship talk is starting to turn me off! I just want to come to Church and hear something positive that will help me grow spiritually!” How did I do? (Scary, isn’t it?)

After all this time, if you think that Stewardship is just a new way for the Church to get more of your money, then I’m afraid you have misunderstood entirely. Stewardship is not a gimmick, or a way to trick you out of your money, or even a tool to make you feel guilty. It’s technically not a program, or even a philosophy. I wouldn’t even say that it is a way of life, but rather, that it is the only way to live! Stewardship is the Authentic Orthodox Christian Lifestyle, and as such, it is both spiritual and positive! This understanding is reflected quite clearly during the period called the Triodion, which we enter into this month.

The Triodion is a ten-week block of time that leads us up to, and prepares us for, the greatest Feast in the Orthodox Christian Calendar, that of Holy Pascha. For those of you who are thinking, “Hey, isn’t Great Lent only 40 days?” – You are not mistaken, but that is only a part of the Triodion period of preparation. The Triodion begins with three weeks of Pre-Lent (22 days actually), that include the Sundays of The Publican and Pharisee, The Prodigal Son, Meatfare (Judgment), and Cheesefare (Forgiveness). Then we enter into Great Lent proper on Clean Monday, which lasts for exactly 40 days. The Saturday of Lazarus and Palm Sunday are not technically part of either Great Lent or Holy Week, but serve as a bridge between the two. The Great and Holy Week of our Lord’s Passion runs from Monday through Holy Saturday, so add another six days. That brings the total time of our preparation for Pascha to 70 days (22+40+2+6=70)! This means that almost 20% of our Liturgical Year is spent preparing for this Great Feast. Compare that to the roughly 10% of the year spent in preparation for the Nativity.

Length of time is not the only difference between these two great periods of preparation. The Triodion also places a greater emphasis on prayer and fasting, with many additional services and a very specific fasting regimen. In terms of fasting, the Church does not hit us with its full force from the beginning, like a 2x4 upside the head; but rather eases us into the practice, like cooking a lobster, as it slowly turns up the heat. The first week of the Triodion is entirely fast free (no fasting even on Wednesday & Friday). The second week is a normal fasting week (i.e. fasting on Wednesday & Friday). The third week, following Meatfare Sunday, is when we say goodbye to all meat (beef, lamb, pork, chicken, etc.), but everything else (especially dairy) is still allowed. After Cheesefare Sunday, we begin our strict regimen of fasting, and add dairy products, fish, and oil & wine to the prohibited list. The Church does relax the Fast (a little) on Saturdays & Sundays (allowing oil & wine), as well as certain Feastdays (fish on Annunciation & Palm Sunday). It is important to consult your Spiritual Father before beginning any fasting regimen, to determine what is best for you! What does any of this have to do with Stewardship? Ah, that mystery will be revealed in Part II next month, as we enter into the Great and Holy Lent.

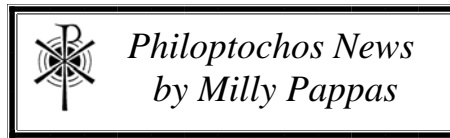




Entertainment at the dinner was presented by Mark and Katherine Damisch
