

Sunday of Orthodoxy

Church school students participate in the Procession of Icons at the end of Divine Liturgy. Remind students the week before to bring in an icon from home to carry in the procession. Extra icons are also available for students who forget.

On the Sunday of Orthodoxy, students and teachers begin lining up as they complete Holy Communion. It is helpful if teachers arrive early at church that day, so they can sit closer to the front, receive Holy Communion sooner, and then go directly to their assigned location to help students line up.

- As children complete communion, they should begin to line up with their class for the procession.
- **N3, N4, and Kindergarten should line up against the wall at the front of the church in the baptismal font area.** Parents should escort their children to that area, and their teachers will be there to wait with them.
- **1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th grades should proceed to the Fellowship Hall.** They will line up with their classes in the designated area by the door to the stairs leading up to the baptismal font area. When the procession is to begin, their teachers will lead them up the spiral staircase by the baptismal font area.
- Participation in the procession for 7th through High School students is optional. Any of these students who would like to process should meet in the Fellowship Hall.
- The procession will end with all students on the solea. Upon dismissal, students and teachers will proceed to their classrooms for a shortened lesson.
