The SS. Peter & Paul Ladies Philoptochos Society is pleased to announce the availability of a scholarship to be awarded to a recipient in good standing (stewards or children of stewards) of Saints Peter & Paul Greek Orthodox Glenview Parish, **who is planning on attending Fanari Camp; Ioanian Village, Hellenic College or any other Orthodox Christian religious educational institution.**

Rules and Eligibility Requirements

1. The Athie Koulogeorge Panarites Scholarship (AKPS) is designed to serve students who attend and whose parents are stewards of the SS. Peter and Paul Greek Orthodox Church of Glenview, IL.
2. In awarding the scholarship, the applications will be evaluated on the following criteria: a balance of both the financial necessity and academic merit.
3. The family of the applicant must be a steward in good standing of the SS. Peter & Paul Greek Orthodox Church of Glenview.
4. Applicants for the AKPS scholarship must be **planning on attending an Orthodox Christian religious educational institution and or camp.**
5. Applicants for Fanari Camp, Ionian Village or any other Orthodox Christian camp may apply prior to enrollment.
6. After completed applications are submitted; this Scholarship Committee reviews them and selects the finalists. The finalists are then interviewed by the Committee for a final decision.
7. The finalists must be available for an in-person interview by the Scholarship Committee by a designated date in early May 2018. All candidates will be contacted for an appointment.
8. The Scholarship Award will be presented in Church on **Graduate Recognition Sunday on May 20, 2018.**
9. The recipient of the Scholarship is expected to attend the Award Presentation on Graduate Recognition Sunday, May 20, 2018 to personally accept the award.
10. If applicable (not always due to the age/grade of candidate), official transcripts, official ACT or SAT test results are required. (see High School Academic Profile form)
