What is Coffee Connection?

Coffee Connection is an educational ministry *for adults* that aims to strengthen the knowledge and practice of the Orthodox faith. Twice a month, all interested adults meet in the youth room under the gym, immediately following Holy Communion, until church school is dismissed, at 11:55. The setting is ideal—everyone gathers in the youth room kitchen for a cup of coffee and to chat with other parishioners. Once all are gathered, participants move into the adjacent room for a presentation and discussion on the day’s topic. The presentation is an opportunity to learn more about the faith, while the discussion emphasizes how to practice Orthodox traditions in our everyday lives.
