

On *Father's Day June 18* we also commemorated the *Feast of All Saints*. We thank all our fathers, grandfathers, godfathers and father-figures for all that you do for us! This year the *Apostles Fast* occurs *June 12-28* and our *Parish Feast Day* is of course on *June 28-29*. Please plan ahead to join us for Vespers on Tuesday evening and Divine Liturgy on Wednesday morning.

Fanari Camp- Week 1 takes place *June 18-24* and Week 2 June 25-July1. Subsequent sessions occur for the next three weeks thereafter.

Does God take Summer vacation? No, and neither does our parish. We are open throughout the summer and Divine Liturgies are schedule for every Sunday and weekdays for major feasts and saints. Even though we do not have Church School classes, we should still come for Sunday Liturgy.

If we are travelling for vacation, we should look for attend and Orthodox Christian Church nearby or on the way. Take a photo with you family inside or in front of the church and send to Fr. Rick if you'd like to share with the community. This is an excellent way to continue to center our life around God and to experience other parishes and styles of worship.

We are thankful that the Metropolis of Chicago has gifted us the services of *Melpomene Murdakes* who has met with our **Stewardship Ministry** team two

times to work on our program. We look forward to sharing the insights we've gained and the new strategies we've learned. Some that I can share now are: shifting from a ministry-centric to a soul-centric model that places God and Church first; understanding and experiencing the Paradox of Generosity (a book title) which is based on shifting our hearts and minds to a mentality of abundance versus a scarcity Honoring the Past, Embracing the Present, and Preparing for the Future; creating a culture of philanthropy (informing, inviting, investing); appreciating, honoring and advancing the generosity of our benefactors.

One book I'm reading now is titled "Money and Salvation: An Invitation to the Good Way" by Andrew Geleris. I recommend this most excellent book to everyone but especially to our stewardship team and parish council. Of the numerous remarkable quotes, we discussed this one: "In contrast to our extreme reluctance to discuss money in church, the Gospels record Jesus teaching far more frequently and intensely about the 'unspiritual' topic of finances than all the 'spiritual' topics that dominate our teaching."



Our 2023 campaign season is winding down: "*Giving Thanks: Eucharist*

Stewardship." Giving is based on gratitude for what we have received. And there is no greater gift and no greater thanks than to receive the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. Our operational expenses in 2023 will be nearly \$1.5M and with necessary capital projects our total is over \$1.7M. With approximately 610 families we need an average stewardship of \$2,824 per individual/couple/ family. Statistics show the average household income for the Northshore area is about \$160K. So, that gives a gauge for being above or below the average. Some might say the hurdle is too high or the increase is too large.

Think of it this way: *if everyone* gave \$3.56 more per day, we would meet this goal. Now some can afford to give \$10, 20 or 30 more per day. Our proportional giving must be generous and sacrificial, giving to God and His Church the first and best fruits of His gifts to us! This month of *June activities* include We will host the Fall of **Constantinople Commemoration** event (June 1); Pentecost and Bishop Neofitos visit (June 4); Feast Day of Holy Trinity Church in Chicago (June 4-5); Clergy Homiletics seminar (June 8); Animal/Pet Blessing service (June 17); Fanari Camp Week 1 (June 18-24) & Week 2 (June 25-July1); Patronal Feast of Saints Peter & Paul--our parish feast day! (June 28-29); Feast Day of Holy Apostles Church in Westchester (June 29-30).

Looking ahead into July – Fanari Week 3 (July 2-8), Independence Day Holiday (July 4), Fanari Week 4 (July 9-15), Fanari Week 5 (July 16-22).

The Construction Zone

Our Construction schedule for 2023 continues to build up steam:

- The first phase of the tuckpointing and masonry repair has been completed. The contractor is working on a phasing plan for the balance of the work.
- The Church HVAC replacement project is in full swing. Anticipated completion date June 9.
- The solar panel contractor is building out the electric room and will start delivering materials this week. Anticipate installation of the solar panels beginning at the end of June, when the panels get delivered.

Coming attractions: other projects, budgeted, paid for and scheduled for 2023:

- Replacement of the two furnaces serving the areas under the gym (Budget \$15K)
- · Installation of guard rails and ADA compliant handrails in the Latto Center. (Budget \$40K)
- Replacement of Atrium clerestory windows (Budget \$30K)
- Annual asphalt repairs (Budget \$15K)
- Concrete Sidewalk replacement in front of Church (Budget \$50K)
