Family Therapy, 2019), Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology (Master of Divinity 1994) in Boston and the University of Minnesota (BS Business Admin & Marketing 1988). Fr. Rick previously served St. George Church in St Paul, MN (1999-2019), St. Paul Police Department volunteer chaplain (2006-2019). He is president of Chicago Clergy Syndesmos (2022-2024) and Vicar of Clergy Wellness. He is married to Presvytera Jane and has one adult son and daughter-in-law.



**Dr. Helen Creticos Theodoropoulos** is a lifelong member of Saints Peter & Paul Church She is a graduate of University of Chicago Divinity School (Ph.D. in Theology 1995; M.A.in Theology 1978), Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology (Master Degree Theological Studies 1981).
