She taught biblical studies and early Christianity extensively at Orthodox and non-Orthodox universities and graduate schools of theology, including Hellenic College/Holy Cross. She is the host of *Search the Scriptures LIVE* on Ancient Faith Radio. Her most recent books are *The Crucifixion of the King of Glory* and *Thinking Orthodox.* She is married to Father Costas and they have one child, Christopher (33).

Background

Raised in Southern California in a Greek American household. Married for 43 years to Father Costas and has one son, Christopher (33).

Presvytera has taught at Hellenic College/Holy Cross Seminary, the Patriarch Athenagoras Orthodox Institute, and most recently, for five years at Ss Cyril and Athanasius Coptic School of Theology and nine years the Franciscan School of Theology. She retired from the University of San Diego after twenty years.

For 40 years, she has led Bible studies, taught, and lectured on the Bible, early Christianity and Orthodoxy at parishes, conferences, retreats and seminars.

Presvytera Jeannie began the first Orthodox internet Bible study podcast sixteen years ago, called <u>Search the Scriptures</u> on **Ancient Faith Radio** (<u>www.ancientfaith.com</u>). It quickly gained an enthusiastic following worldwide. For the past four years she has hosted a live call-in program on Ancient Faith, *Search the Scriptures LIVE*! on Mondays at 8 pm Eastern/5 pm Pacific. Over 350 of her Bible study podcast lessons are available for free at at orthodoxbiblestudy.info. Her PhD research was on the Apocalypse in the Ancient Church of the East. She translated the oldest Greek patristic commentary on Revelation, written by Andrew of Caesarea, into a modern language. This translation was published by the Catholic University of America Press in 2012 as *The Fathers of the Church*, Volume 123. She also authored, *Guiding to a Blessed End: Andrew of Caesarea and his Apocalypse Commentary in the Ancient Church*, about the Apocalypse in the Eastern Church. Her two most recent books are *Thinking Orthodox: Understanding and Acquiring the Orthodox Christian Mind* and *The Crucifixion of the King of Glory: The Amazing History and Sublime Mystery of the Passion.*
